### School admissions

If you have, or if you know of a family, with a child who was born between **01.09.14** and **31.08.15** please be reminded that they are therefore due to start school in September 2019. The admission process closes on the 15th January 2019. This is done through Leicestershire County Council and can be done online. However, if you wish your child to start here with us at Holy Cross a Supplementary form must also be filled out. It can be collected from the school office and must be returned directly to us.
